In Re: Application for Exemption from the Electronic Public Access Fees by Guillermo Andrés Morales Sancho

This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by **Guillermo Andrés Morales Sancho** for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that Guillermo Andrés Morales Sancho, an individual researcher associated with an educational institution, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Guillermo Andrés Morales Sancho has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Guillermo Andrés Morales Sancho shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of researching tort cases, and how different discovery procedures in the United States (compared to the lack of pre-trial discovery in Europe) affect the outcome of tort cases. Guillermo Andrés Morales Sancho shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- I. this fee exemption applies only to **Guillermo Andrés Morales Sancho**, and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
- II. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;
- III. by accepting this exemption, **Guillermo Andrés Morales Sancho** agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
- IV. **Guillermo Andrés Morales Sancho** is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases;
- V. this exemption is valid until January 19, 2022.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
